1. TICKETS – Kids under 17yo and under are free, only ADULTS pay

Entry Gate Prices

3 day on Friday \$130 per adult

2 day sold on Saturday \$80 per adult (if you leave by 11pm, \$30 will be refunded to you at the gate on your way out)

1 day sold on Sunday \$30 per adult

Discounted adult tickets are \$100 (until Dec 31) available online at www.mcav.com.au

Please note the online price increases after Jan 1, 2017 to \$120.

If you are able it is well worth coming Friday and leaving Monday morning. The weekend is excellent value for money with 2 days and 3 nights of entertainment.

2. Gates do not open until 9am on Friday.
3. Bitumen road to the site boundary.
4. Food and drink stalls on site. If you don't feel like cooking there will be full catering from daylight till after dark. Everything from a sit down meal to tasty take away as well as ice creams and other treats for the kids.
5. BAR - There is an excellent bar with a great atmosphere; we pride ourselves on responsibly serving a variety of beers, mixed drinks and ice all at reasonable prices. The bar opens at 5pm on Friday.
6. You do not need to book camping sites. Camp sites are 'first in best dressed'. Try to arrive during daylight to make finding and setting up camp easier. There will be a quieter camping area for families and people who don't want to party all night. Please do not camp in this area if you think you may have a loud camp! There is a designated horse camping area.
7. Showers and toilets are provided and regularly cleaned and serviced.
8. Fresh drinking water on site for everyone at no cost. Bring your own container.
9. Strictly no camp fires allowed.
10. Yes, you can bring your pet as long as it is kept on a leash or confined.
11. You may bring your own food and alcohol but please remember no glass and please clean up after yourself. Bins are located throughout the event site, please use them.
12. No glass please.

13. There is a first aid tent with qualified staff located on site.
14. Mobile reception is available, although it may be
